



## 2024 GRADUATING SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

### SECTION 1: Scholarship Information and Application Requirements

#### A. Applicants must currently meet the following criteria:

- Reside in Skagit or Island counties
- Be a graduating high school senior and plan to attend a college or university to pursue a degree
- Be a dependent of an active-duty, retired, or deceased military service member

#### B. Applicants must submit the following documents IN ORDER:

1. Complete Applicant Information and Scholarship Questionnaire (see next page)
2. Official high school transcript
3. A résumé of school activities, community service, honors, awards, and work experience (max of two pages)
4. Two essays (maximum of 300 words each):
  - a. An essay of your educational and career goals
  - b. An essay addressing your strengths and weaknesses and how they will help you or challenge you to achieve your educational and career goals
5. One recommendation letter from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer/supervisor, or religious leader

C. Submission Requirements:

1. The OSCWI Scholarship Committee must receive this completed application and all additional required materials no later than April 15th, 2024. Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.
